#### Today's Gospel: Mark 1:29-39

On leaving the synagogue Jesus entered the house of Simon and Andrew with James and John. Simon's mother-in-law lay sick with a fever. They immediately told him about her. He approached, grasped her hand, and helped her up. Then the fever left her and she waited on them.

When it was evening, after sunset, they brought to him all who were ill or possessed by demons. The whole town was gathered at the door. He cured many who were sick with various diseases, and he drove out many demons, not permitting them to speak because they knew him.

Rising very early before dawn, he left and went off to a deserted place, where he prayed. Simon and those who were with him pursued him and on finding him said, "Everyone is looking for you." He told them, "Let us go on to the nearby villages that I may preach there also. For this purpose, have I come." So he went into their synagogues, preaching and driving out demons throughout the whole of Galilee.





The Ignatian Spirituality & Formation and Care for Creation Committees Invite You to a Lenten Eight-Week Spiritual Exercises Series:

### Bring Christ to the World

What: The series will be an eight-week guided prayer experience for small groups, modeled on the Spiritual Exercises of Saint Ignatius of Loyola. Each group will meet weekly for about an hour. Participants can choose Sundays after the 9:30 am Mass, Sundays after the 11:30 am Mass, or Tuesdays at 10 am. Each week will have a theme. During the weeks between meetings, participants will pray and reflect on scriptural readings on their own in accord with each theme. Participants will gather each week in small groups to share reflections and experiences of the weekly prayer periods.

When and Where: The first meetings will be Sunday,

February 11 and Tuesday, February 13, respectively, and will meet weekly in the OSJ Rectory. The series will run for eight consecutive weeks, with exception to Easter Sunday and Easter Tuesday. The last meetings will be held on Sunday, April 7 and Tuesday, April 9.


