We are excited to announce that Old St. Joe's has been accepted into the Children, Liturgy, Ecology, and Renewal (CLEAR) Project directed by Villanova University and funded by a grant from the Lilly Endowment. CLEAR is a 2year project beginning this fall whose aim is to increase children's participation in liturgy, help them develop a sense of environmental stewardship, and help churches (Catholic and other Christian denominations) and faithbased schools integrate children's faith formation, worship, and ecology as well as to bring together an ecumenical group of churches/schools in Philadelphia. Two representatives from each institution who work with children have been accepted as Fellows in the program. OSJ's Fellows are Christine Szczepanowski, PREP Coordinator, and Nina Vitullo, CLOW Coordinator. The Project will culminate with an initiative developed by each pair of Fellows for their own institution.

this message.

Please be on the lookout for similar emails AND PLEASE DO NOT RESPOND TO THEM. There is always a sense of urgency with these scam emails which is one clue. They are also always very brief and Fr. Hannafey's email address (fhannafey@oldstjoseph.org) is never the email address they use. 


