
August 25, 2024 | The 21st Sunday in Ordinary Time (B)



Today's Gospel Reading: John 6:60-69

Many of Jesus' disciples who were listening said, "This saying is hard; who can accept it?" Since Jesus knew that his disciples were murmuring about this, he said to them, "Does this shock you? What if you were to see the Son of Man ascending to where he was before? It is the spirit that gives life, while the flesh is of no avail. The words I have spoken to you are Spirit and life. But there are some of you who do not believe." Jesus knew from the beginning the ones who would not believe and the one who would betray him. And he said, "For this reason I have told you that no one can come to me unless it is granted him by my Father."

As a result of this, many of his disciples returned to their former way of life and no longer accompanied him. Jesus then said to the Twelve, "Do you also want to leave?" Simon Peter answered him, "Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy One of God."



Old Saint Joseph's New LGBTQ Prayer Group - Inspired by Catholic Synodality: Robert Lord-Schell, a new member of our Parish Pastoral Council, says that he was inspired to organize our new LGBTQ prayer group in response to the presentation by a participant to the Vatican Synod discussions on LGBTQ issues. The participant, whom the Archdiocese of Philadelphia appointed to attend the Synod, expressed the opinion that healing needs to occur for both LGBTQ Catholics and the greater Catholic community due to past misunderstandings and miscommunication. This healing will only happen if the dialogue among them proceeds through synodal, prayerful communication, not only on a global level but also between individuals in the church. This message really made sense to Rob. He wanted to take this mission and put it into action by creating an inclusive LGBTQ prayer group here at Old Saint Joseph's.

In starting the prayer group, Rob was determined not only to expand the inclusivity that our Parish values (our motto is "All Are Welcome Here") but also to build on Jesuit principles. He modeled the group on another LGBTQ prayer group at St. John the Evangelist Parish in Philadelphia that meets regularly for prayer, scripture reading, and discussion.


Rob began by bringing the idea to the Pastor and to the Parish Pastoral Council. The Pastor and Parish Council agreed that it was a promising idea. Rob reached out to people who might want to participate, and the group was up and running quickly. The LBGTQ prayer group has met several times at this point.


