

Today's Gospel: Mark 9: 30-37

Jesus and his disciples left from there and began a journey through Galilee, but he did not wish anyone to know about it. He was teaching his disciples and telling them, "The Son of Man is to be handed over to men and they will kill him, and three days after his death the Son of Man will rise." But they did not understand the saying, and they were afraid to question him.

They came to Capernaum and, once inside the house, he began to ask them, "What were you arguing about on the way?" But they remained silent. They had been discussing among themselves on the way who was the greatest. Then he sat down, called the Twelve, and said to them, "If anyone wishes to be first, he shall be the last of all and the servant of all." Taking a child, he placed it in the their midst, and putting his arms around it, he said to them, "Whoever receives one child such as this in my name, receives me; and whoever receives me, receives not me but the One who sent me."

Sacrament of Reconciliation

Tues., Wed., & Thurs: Please approach the presiding priest directly after the 12:05 Mass to request reconciliation.

Sacrament of Baptism

Persons wanting to arrange a baptism should call Christine Szczepanowski at the parish office at least two months before the desired date to arrange catechesis and the baptism celebration.

Anointing of the Sick

The anointing of the sick takes place during the 7:30 Mass on the First Sunday of each month.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Persons wanting to be married in the parish should call the front office at least nine months before the desired date.

Rite of Christian Initiation

Unbaptized adults who are considering baptism into the Catholic Church, baptized Catholics who have received no other sacraments and who want to be confirmed and to receive First Eucharist, and baptized non-Catholics who are considering full communion in the Catholic Church should call Christine Szczepanowski at the parish office.

I would like to invite you to join the Hospital Ministry and have the opportunity to share the rewards I and other hospital ministers have experienced. I joined the ministry because, having worked and volunteered in the medical field all my life, I thought this would be a wonderful way to provide service in the Ignatian way. I expected that I would bring Communion to the patients and pray with them, and I shadowed other ministers to learn the process by which I would serve them.

I did not know the spiritual and religious experience that I would have in this ministry. Let me share how I have experienced Jesus' presence at the hospital. One experience that I will never forget is going to give communion to a young man paralyzed from the neck down. We talked about Jesus and the Catholic faith in one of the most religious conversations that I have ever had. Another experience was walking into a room where a whole family was present and asked to pray together for their family member. That was one of the most spiritual group experiences that I have had outside of church. Yet the most gratifying experience is when I give someone Communion and they start crying out of gratitude that I have brought it to them. Their gratitude makes me feel grateful to Jesus for allowing me to share in his ministry. I hope sharing my experiences stirs your interest in discussing the ministry with me.
